Participation

Register for this race well in advance (limited number of starting slots available!!) – on a course that will be blocked off from regular vehicle traffic. In previous years, registration had to be closed even before the official deadline due to such huge interest. Ages 15 and up (born in or before 2005).

Course

Public traffic will be blocked off from the course between 12:15 and 6:45 p.m.

Start

The race begins at the starting ramp located on the event grounds at the Kammer marina in Schörfling am Attersee.

Finish

Kammer marina (starting area)

Distance

47.2 km/280 vertical meters

The Attersee is circled in a clockwise direction (Weyregg – Unterach – Attersee). This also applies to the Unterach detour.

Starting Time
