Participation

The registration period will start on April 5th, 2024 and will be open for 17 days until April 21st, 2024. Then the starting places for the solo riders and 4 man teams will be drawn from the registrations collected. Registration from 15 years (born in or before 2009).

The race begins at the starting ramp located on the event grounds at the Kammer marina in Schörfling am Attersee.
